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The only other stream sediment anomalies were minor Cu and Zn anomalies near the Lisle goldfield and Cu and/or Zn anomalies near Tertiary Basalt.

Similarly, apart from minor Zn values (to 500ppm) from areas of contact between the Mathinna Beds and Jurassic dolerite, there were no significant ferruginous gravel anomalies.

One panned concentrate sample (A119428 from the Golconda fields) showed 0.84ppm Au. All other samples showed no anomalies.

Surprisingly the Lefroy goldfield in the far northwest of the sheet (A119414) showed no anomalous samples.

No further work is required on this area except in the areas of the known goldfields. These are all held under Exploration Licences and/or (more particularly) Mining Leases.

A low priority minor sampling programme in the headwater of the Little Forester River (A119447) should be undertaken if in the area.

(vi) Break O'Day 1:100,000 sheet

Essentially only 2 sample sets on this sheet - remainder of samples discussed on the Georges Bay sheet (north) and St. Pauls sheet (west).
