

MH208.20 on line 4NE were thought to represent gabbro/dolerite dykes. The area of EM 196.69 on line 3SW in the Amber Creek area was investigated in detail by geophoto Resources Consultants with negative results.

The only other investigation of E.L. 15/76 to date by CSR was a Dighem survey in 1981/82. This located 35 initial anomalies. Examination of previous investigations of the areas of these anomalies resulted in only 5 anomalies requiring further investigation (Appendix XXIV).

The southwestern portion of the Licence (southwest of the Murchison Highway) has been joint ventured to Amoco Minerals Australia Ltd. Amoco are gridding all surface exposures of the Gordon Limestone and traversing these grids with auger soil geochemistry, magnetics and gravity.
