DIGHEM RESULTS, E.L. 15/76 (DUNDAS), TASMANIA

I refer to my memo of 2nd July, 1982 to Mr. P. Ellis re the preliminary assessment of data, with particular reference to Attachment B.

On 24th November, Mr. Ellis and I examined these anomaly locations in relation to his recently completed compilation of previous geophysical, geochemical and drilling results (this compilation does not include most of Mr. Macnamara's work which is not yet committed to plan).

Much of the E.L. was surveyed by Turair (Rio Tinto program). Few Turair's anomalies occur in the northern part of the E.L.; most anomalies were located about the Amber Creek grid in the southern portion of the E.L. Hence it is not possible to make a comparison between Turair and DIGHEM results (although there is a Turair anomaly "D" over Blackjacks which was barely covered by DIGHEM).

A preliminary copy of the remapped ZEEHAN sheet was also useful in assessing some anomaly locations. An uncoloured version of this sheet will be available before the end of the year.

The following notes refer to those anomalies in Attachment B (of the earlier memo) which require assessment by CSR only. Ground checking should use VLF-EM, magnetics and soil geochemistry if required.
