

New and Recent Workings on Reefs commencing
from the Northern end of Lefroy Field.

Information on the following Reefs and workings
is only approximately correct, some information
having been obtained second-hand.

Rockliffs Reef, situation, approx. 1 mile North of Perpetual Line. A Reef running East and West was discovered in the year 1900 several prospecting shafts has been sank on the Lode the deepest being 60ft. Some fairly rich stone is said to have been obtained. The Lode being small work was abandoned. Underlay is southward.

Golden Zone, this reef was discovered in the year 1902. A main shaft 190 ft in depth, whip shaft 100 ft and several small shafts have been sank on the reef. In the whip shaft at a level of 60 ft. a crushing was taken out and is said to have yielded 2 oz per ton. Gold was also seen at the bottom level.

In the main shaft a crosscut was put in at 180 ft from surface. The lode was here cut and considerable amount of driving done but no gold was obtained. Reef very small 3 or 4 inches. Underlay south.

Situation, about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile north of Perpetual Line of Reef.

Comrades This reef was located in the year 1898. Some rich stone was taken out from 60 ft to the surface. A whip shaft sunk 95 ft and a considerable amount of driving at this depth failed to show any gold, underlay south. This reef is probably the Perpetual Reef going west.

Equilla

A small Reef discovered in the year 1917. A number of shafts to a depth of 60 ft have been sunk on the Lode width of same average 9 inches. The stone carries from $\frac{1}{2}$ oz to $1\frac{1}{2}$ per ton, underlay south.

South Perpetual

A number of shafts to a depth of 60 ft has been sunk on what is believed to be the Perpetual Lode. Some rich stone was found in a 60 ft shaft, a drive was put in East on the reef but a slide was encountered and no lode could be found on the Eastern side of this fault, underlay south.

Nugget

Situation Midway between Morning Star and Youth Reefs and a fair amount of driving East and West at this level failed to show any gold. At 100 ft west ran into basalt and discontinued driving.

McIvor

About 5 chains South of Golden Point Line, a small reef was discovered showing rich stone at surface but a shaft sunk 100 ft and also a fair amount of driving failed to show anything of any importance.

Wallis

This supposed line of Reef was found in the year 1930. Having seen this reef I am surprised at this being called a reef. About 1 inch os stone was cut from the shaft running East and West but on driving a few feet the Leader cut out. A drive has been put in 125 ft to the south and 50 ft to the north, no Lodes seen in either drives. The reef or leader, underlays north. Shaft 90 ft in depth situated a few chains North of Brisbane Line of Reef.

Leifloyd

This Reef was found in the year 1931, several shafts has been sunk on the lode. The deepest being 75ft in depth at 50 ft level from the shaft the same being 18 inches in width and carrying gold to the extent of 1 oz per ton. On driving on this formation it was found to get small. The shaft was then sunk a further 20 ft and the Reef cut at 70 ft from surface. The Lode here is also small no driving has been done at this level. Situation, 7 chains south of Windemere Line of Reef, underlay south.

Blue Jacket

This Reef was discovered in the year 1900 and carried some rich stone at surface. One crushing of 5 tons giving a little over ten ounces of gold. The old Australasia main shaft was unwatered and the lode cut about 50 ft north of the shaft, a drive was put in about 70 ft to the East of the Reef. Very little gold was seen at this level. There is some doubt as to whether this level was carried far enough East to intercept the chute of stone found in a prospecting shaft East of the Australasia Main Shaft. Exaustion of funds cased the mine to close down, underlay north.

Arcade

The Arcade Reef is situated about 2 chains south of the Blue Jacket Line. This Reef is small but carried some rich stone near the surface but apparently the gold did not live down a shaft sunk 50 ft in depth also a fair amount of driving at this level failed to show any gold. Underlay south.

Princess Alice

This line of Reef is supposed to be the Western continuation of the Brisbane Lode. A shaft sunk 100 ft and some driving on Lode at this level failed to show any gold. Lode is said to average 2 ft in width and underlay south west and on the same line a fair amount of surface

prospecting on the Lode has failed to open up anything of much value.

Gift

A rich but small reef was discovered in the year 1913. A whip shaft was put down 100 ft and the reef cut at 60 ft and 90 ft from the surface. One crushing of 11 tons of stone gave a return of 55 ozs of gold. Later the reef was cut from the old Reward shaft 200 ft but proved to be of no value, underlay south. Situation approx. 200 ft south of Reward Line of Reef.

Golden Crest

This is another small reef situated about 4 chains north of Reward Line some rich stone was found in a prospecting shaft 40 ft in depth a crushing of 5 tons taken out returned 10 ozs of gold. The Reef was thin cut from the Reward shaft at the 200 ft Level, but was only a few inches wide, underlay south.

About 100 ft north of this Line another Reef was also cut from the Reward shaft the Reef being about 2 ft in width and carrying a little gold. No driving was done on the Reef, underlay south.

South of the Enterprise Line of Reef, two Reefs have recently been found, one of these is of a soft formation width from 2 ft to 3 ft, a number of potholes to a depth of 7 ft has been put down on the Lode, no gold has been seen, underlay south.

Another Reef south of the above mentioned one has been cut in a number of trenches, a little gold was seen also some antimony in the stone.

A Reef about 2 miles south of the Volunteer Line has been cut by a number of trenches. This Lode is a big formation and carries a little gold and a fair amount of silver. Very little development work has been carried out, underlay south.

West of the Clansman Workings and on the same line of Reef a shaft was put down 70 ft on the lode a drive put in east and west 70 ft showed the Reef to be 2 ft in width and carrying values to the extent of 2 oz. per ton. The Reef for 70 ft is believed to be / oz stone. Endeavours are being made to further prospect the property.
