SUBJECT: Rehabilitation of Drill Pad FDD01 at the Vanderfeen Property.

DATE: June 3rd 2006

NEW NORTH FARRELL DRILL RIG SITES FDD01, FDD02 & FDD03.

- Drill site was located on private property. One pad was occupied during the drilling of the three holes.
- Permission was sought and granted from the land holder prior to occupying the site (see letter on file 6th September 2005)
- **Location Descriptor:** 150m NW of the Vanderfeen House, just off the Innes Track at the old batch plant.
- Access to the site was via the Mackintosh Dam Road then west along an existing wide open gravel track. Little to no clearing was required to position the drill rig.
- To avoid additional clearing and felling of trees, only sump was excavated (extra deep) for the drilling
- The site was visited during the drilling operation by David Gatehouse the Mineral Resources of Tasmania Environmental Field Officer (see attached letter dated 6th November)
- The sump was filled in shortly after drilling ceased. Due to the depth of the sump the cuttings were well below the half way mark. It was not deemed necessary to pump the water from the sump by a septic tanker. Environmental matting was used to remove any surface film.
- Two packers were installed at 24m depth to stop water flow from the drill collar.
- Drill rig pad was rehabilitated by Williams Earth Moving Contractors from Queenstown, and under the instruction of the landowner Neil Vanderfeen, and in the presence of site supervisor Andrew Habets. Small Radiata Pine was removed at the request of the landowner
- No PVC collar was place on this site as the landowner proposed to occupy the site
- Work was completed on 22nd of November 2005. Additional aggregate was placed on the site at the request of the landowner in January 2006. The owner intends to utilise the cleared site for grazing of horses.
- **Total** movement time of machine **3 hours.**
- The site was again visited by David Gatehouse, accompanied by John Pemberton, and in the presence of Andrew Habets on 22nd March, 2006. Satisfaction at the environmental condition of all sites was expressed.
