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(a) SAMPLE SITES.

Stream sediment and soil samples were taken from various locations, adjacent to the Previous sample sites shown below.

Listed below and on the map are the sample site locations.

Sample site J; 55GCP406948,AGD66.

Sample site K; 55GCP405945,AGD66.

Sample site L; 55GCP406943,AGD66.

Sample site M; 55GCP406942,AGD66.

(c) SAMPLE REPORT.

Stream sediment and soil samples taken at locations J and K had virtually no heavy mineral content ,which backs up previous results for sample sites F and G .

The Northern half of the tenement appears to be largely barren of heavy minerals and gemstone.

Samples taken from location L ,as a follow up to samples from location I ,yielded only a small trace of heavy mineral , consisting of just a few grains of chromite.

Samples gained from location M , South East of location I , had no heavy mineral content.

The heavy mineral content , in samples taken East of the original sample sites C and D , tends to diminish with distance away from sites C&D .

(d) PROPOSED WORK.

Our field work indicates that the source of the heavy minerals, is not likely to lie in the Northern and Eastern quadrants of the tenement.
More samples will be taken in the area between the original sample sites A&E and C &D in the South west corner of the tenement .

(e) EXPENDITURE.

The total expenditure for 2006/2007 financial year was \$3500.00.
