


Plate 1 – Sample 152801 – Medium grained granodiorite with epidote altered xenoliths and micro granite phase



Plate 2 – Sample 152802 – Pyrite veined hornblende granodiorite




Plate 3 – Samples 152803 and 152804 (below) – Potassic and sodic altered granite and granodiorite (Dove Granite)





Plate 4 – Samples 152805 and 152806 – Medium grained granite and potassically altered granite (typical Dove Granite)




Plate 5 – Sample 152807 - Strongly sodic alteration, probable granodiorite/ quartz diorite.
