

Lot #1 Heavy concentrate with corundum, zircon, topaz and other types of stones. Approximately 80% corundum by weight. Very low yield only in sizes under 2mm.

Lot #2 Heavy concentrate with corundum, zircon, topaz and other types of stones. Approximately 60% corundum by weight. Very low yield only in sizes under 2mm.

Lot #3 Heavy concentrate with corundum, zircon, topaz and other types of stones. Approximately 60% corundum by weight. Very low yield only in sizes under 2mm.

Lot #4 Heavy concentrate with corundum, zircon, topaz and other types of stones. Approximately 90% corundum by weight. Very low yield only in sizes under 2mm.

Lot #5 Greenish brown corundum with very low yield under 2mm.

Lot #6 Grayish blue corundum with very low yield under 2mm.

Lot #7 Grayish blue corundum mostly with low yield in stones 2mm and smaller. A couple if individual pieces might cut as large as 3mm with one piece that might be 5x3mm or 4mm in size.

Lot #8 Zircon and topaz mix with little or no corundum.

Lot #9 Zircon and topaz mix with some small lavender pieces that may be corundum. No corundum that will cut more than 2mm size.

Lot #10 Greenish brown corundum with very low yield under 2mm.

Lot #11 Small black spinel to cut only 3mm and smaller.

Lot #12 Single large piece of black spinel. Largest piece of black spinel seen to date from Tasmania.
