DEVONIAN	
SDhw Pale-weathering, cross-bedded, well-sorted marine quartz sandstone with minor siltstone and conglomerate	
ORDOVICIAN	
Ogt Limestone	
Os Sandstone and minor conglomerate; marine fossils in places	Osh Siltstone; marine fossils in place
MIDDLE CAMBRIAN	
Cmab (Cmab) Andesitic to basaltic volcanic rocks.	Cmabi Intrusive bodies related to andesites.
Cmva Volcano-sedimentary sequences of sandstone, siltstone and conglomerate with intercalated andesitic volcanics and intrusives, felsic volcanics and intrusives and minor basalts. Partially equivalent to Tyndall Group. (Noddy Creek Volcanics and correlates).





Figure 5: VTEM Anomalies in EL 23/2007
