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1 ABSTRACT

This report details the work completed on RL1/2011 for the twelve-month period ending 30th April 2019.

RL1/2011 (1sq km) basically covers the known locations of the Pinafore and Chum Reefs at Lefroy. These 2 reefs historically produced around 100,000oz of gold.

Whilst the early producers targeted ½ - 1oz high grade reefs, there remains a potential for an open cuttable resource or alluvial/eluvial lead resource to still remain.

2. INTRODUCTION

Little field exploration work was done during 2018-2019, due to lack of financial resources in another difficult trading year. However, a costeaning program was conducted in the last week of the period of the reporting year.

Several attempts to locate a Joint Venture partner or a purchaser with greater resources were made, to no avail.

3. TENEMENT STATUS

The Retention Licence (RL1/2011) covers 1 square kilometre in north-eastern Tasmania, just north of Lefroy Township on the road to Beechford about 45km north of Launceston. See **Figure 1**.

The Licence (6 sq km) was originally granted to BCD Resources NL on 23rd April 2012 for a period of 2 years. The Licence was subsequently transferred to Ron Gregory effective from the 6th March 2013.

BCD Resources NL (previously named Beaconsfield Gold NL {BGL}) acquired the Exploration Licences covering the Lefroy Goldfield and other areas from Lefroy Resources Ltd (LRL) in 2008, of which RL1/2011 is a small remaining part thereof.

The Licence contains no excluded areas and covers the known location of the Pinafore and Chum Reefs.

4 TOPOGRAPHY AND ACCESS

RL1/2011 is located largely within the State Forest and Crown Land and accessed by the Council maintained Lefroy – Beechford road (bitumen), which runs south-north through the tenement.

The terrain is undulating, and vegetation is mostly light, open, eucalyptus forest, which has been extensively cutover for firewood. The vegetation has fully recovered after the hot fire in March 2015.

5. GEOLOGY AND MINERALISATION

The Lefroy Goldfield is in the Stoney Head Sandstone within 2km contact with the Turquoise Bluff Slate. The Stoney Head Sandstone is a thick bedded and typically unfossiliferous sandstone dominated succession (Reed, 2004).

A complete synopsis of the regional geology can be found in Baxter and Fulton (2006) – included as Appendix A, 2006 Annual technical report. (06_5386)

6 PREVIOUS EXPLORATION AND MINING

Pre 2004 and 2004-2007 is summarized in the last Lefroy Project Annual Technical Report (Lloyd, 2007) (07_5543)

BGL had Coffey Mining Pty Ltd reinterpreted the LRL work on the Pinafore Reef and generated a JORC compliant Inferred Resource of 810,000 tonnes @ 1.46 g/t Au for 37,900 oz. Recommendations were made for further drilling. BCD drilled 13 percussion holes in 2010, 10 of which achieved intersections in the order of 0.5-3.4 g/t Au. The drilling “confirmed the southerly dip of the Pinafore Reef, but unfortunately no evidence of higher grade mineralization in the up-dip portion of the resource was encountered. The 2010 drilling firmed up the view that the main concentration of mineralised shoots with dip direction continuity is west of the Beechford Road and that the resource overall is of marginal size and grade and would require a prolonged stable period of very high gold price (or gold hedging) to justify development. Drilling coverage through the Pinafore Reef and the abandoned underground workings is now considered sufficient and no further drilling is planned in the near future” (Morrison 2010).

An in-house report (non JORC compliant but prepared under JORC guidelines) was prepared by David Gibbons, Senior Geologist of BCD Resources in October 2011, following the above drilling.

7. WORKS COMPLETED PRIOR TO REPORT PERIOD

2013 – 2014: Rehabilitation of historic drillhole caps as required by the agreement with BCD.

Review of previous reports.

4.5 sq. km. surrendered.

2014 – 2015: Review of previous reporting on alluvial gold potential.

Commenced mapping of surface workings west of the Beechford road, following fire.

2015 – 2016: Continued mapping of surface workings as above.

Engaged Grant MacDonald to undertake a review of the exploration potential of the licence.

Commenced research into historic newspaper reports on the Pinafore, Chum and Unity mines.

2016 – 2017: Continued mapping surface workings.

Continued newspaper research.

Licence reduced to 1 sq. km.

2017 – 2018: Detected Pinafore Reef for coarse gold.

Continued Pinafore and Chum reefs newspaper research.

Exclusive option entered into with John Canaris.

8. WORKS COMPLETED DURING REPORT PERIOD

8.1 Research into historical 1881 newspaper reports on the Chum line of reef.

Continued to compile records relating to the Chum Reef. This is a “work in progress” and a spreadsheet is included at **Appendix 1**.

Individual pdfs of the newspaper reports are in **Appendix 2**.

This work is being conducted to get a better understanding of the origin and help with the difficulty in naming and allocating responsibility for the surface workings.

8.2 Attempts to locate a Joint Venture partner or purchaser.

The exclusive option entered into with John Canaris of Tracker Geoservices Pty Ltd in September 2016 enabling him to market, convert or sell RL1/2011, remains in place. To date nothing has transpired.

The sale of the Beaconsfield Mill is being watched with interest and am awaiting its finalisation before approaching eventual purchaser.

8.3 Costeaning program in the last week of the period.

Although I forecast no fieldwork during the 2018-19 year an opportunity came available for 2 detector mates, one of which is a geologist, with their 7-ton excavator to dig 3 costeans and 1 pit west of the Beechford Road. See **Figure 3**.

This work was planned for March but was delayed until the 20th April.

The areas targeted were:

1. Pinafore Reef immediately west of the Beechford Road. The costean struck mullock that has been placed in surface stoping of the reef. No coarse gold was detected in the excavation.
2. Chum Reef west of the “Our Boys” workings. This area was chosen because of anomalous soil sample results and because no modern drilling has been conducted. An old trench was re-dug and the quartz reef about 0.5 metre wide exposed.

The surface and immediate downslope area of the reef was cleared and detected for coarse gold with nil results, however a small piece of native copper was found.

3. A series of old prospecting trenches, trending north - south exist north of the old track leading to the Unity Mine and south of New Chum Creek. This was thought unusual as they could not possibly be relative to the Chum Reef and it is thought they are targeting a shallow "Lead" of alluvial/eluvial running parallel to the reef and New Chum Creek. This is an exciting find as it is similar to what exists at Back Creek. Hopefully it contains gold.

A costean was dug to 2.7metres depth, parallel to the old workings and "Wash" similar to Back Creek was exposed. A sandy gravel "Wash" about 0.8 metre in thickness exists at 1.2metres depth. This overlays a very clayey "Wash" to the depth of 2.7metres. The bedrock was not attained due to the hardness of the bottom wash and the requirement for a heavier excavator. A sample of 1.5 loose cubic metres of the "Wash" was taken for processing at Back Creek. No coarse gold was detected.

4. A pit 2 metres deep was dug in the course of New Chum Creek. A decomposed slate bottom was encountered at 1.5 metres with no accumulation of gravel on the bedrock. It is assumed that this section of the creek is recent and therefore no accumulation of auriferous gravel exists. A small sample was taken for later processing. No coarse gold was detected.

9. PROPOSED EXPLORATION 2019-2020

- Continue to review existing geological and historical data
- Continue developing the map of historical surface workings through newspaper research.
- Continue to look for a company with sufficient funds to further exploration.
- Process the samples from the costeaning and assess results.
- Conduct further costeaning programs targeting both reef caps and possible alluvial/eluvial “Lead” material.

10. ENVIRONMENTAL

All costeans and the pit were immediately filled in and rehabilitated following examination.

11. EXPENDITURE


The value of work done by the author was \$41,985 to the 30th April 2019.




