Andrew River

Location: At Point - Pillinger 2/20736; 55,32. approximately  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile east of the Andrew River,  $5\frac{1}{2}$  miles upstream from its junction with the Franklin.

The prospect consisted of limonitic staining of contorted chloritic, sericitic and micaceous schists striking  $340^{\circ}$  and dipping  $60-70^{\circ}$  to the west.

Some limonitic boxwork was found in one joint plane but there was no sign of other mineralisation.

I tested samples of the schist and boxwork for Pb, Zn and Cu and got negative results.

These limonitic stainings extend for several miles southwards along the Engineer Range just below the Owen Conglomerate but nowhere was other mineralisation found.
