11/5, 17/2a, 18/6, 21/1.

Fourth Order Priority:

5/2, 10/2, 10/3a, 10/4, 10/5, 10/6,
10/7, 17/6a, 18/1, 18/3, 18/11a,
20/1, 20/8, 21/12, 23/2.
