Selection of Order of Priorities.Contd.

One important factor influencing the selection has been to ensure the inclusion in the higher priority lists of a range of the more favourable E.M. anomalies, related to a particular set of magnetic and geological conditions. Thus in the event of one anomaly of a particular set proving interesting, the raising of priorities of other members of the set or at least similar anomalies, may be warranted.

Assessment of Anomalies.

N.B. Order within priority group is numerical.
