DEPTH	STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION
250-255	<u>Silty mudstone</u> , medium brown, white, coarsely textured, moderately to well compacted, scattered red, brown, grey and white quartz and lithic silt fragments, white and brown clay matrix.
255-260	<u>Silt</u> , white and brown, coarsely textured, moderately compacted, common clear quartz and grey, brown, orange and black lithic grains set in white clay matrix.
260-265	<u>Silt</u> , as 260-265 above, except scattered large brown clay inclusions.
265-270	<u>Silt</u> , as 265-270 above.
270-275	<u>Silt</u> , as 265-270 above.
275-280	<u>Silt</u> , as 265-270 above, except becoming more sandy.
280-285	<u>Silt</u> , as 280-285 above.
285-290	<u>Silt</u> , as 280-285 above, plus scattered carbonaceous grains - 5%.
290-295	<u>Sandy silt</u> , very coarsely textured, medium brown and white, clear, grey and white silt size quartz set in white and light brown clay and matrix, loosely compacted.
295-300	<u>Silt</u> , as 280-285 above.
300-305	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 295-300 above, except white, brown and orange clay matrix is abundant.
305-315	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 295-300 above.
315-320	<u>Sandy clay</u> , medium brown speckled white, scattered clear quartz, fine grained, set in brown and white clay matrix.
320-325	<u>Silty mudstone</u> , medium brown, scattered white, coarse textured, loosely to moderately compacted, scattered clear fine grained quartz set in white and brown clay matrix.
325-330	<u>Sandy silt</u> , medium brown, coarsely textured with fine to coarse grains of white clear quartz set in a brown clay and silt matrix, loosely to moderately compacted.
330-335	<u>Silty sand</u> , clear, minor white (vein) and red and orange, fine grained, sub-angular, medium sorted quartz, set in brown silty matrix, loosely to moderately compacted, rare minute carbonaceous fragments.
335-340	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 330-335 above.
340-345	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 330-335 above.
345-350	<u>Sandy silt</u> , finely grained of clear white (vein) and minor brown clay and black lithic grains set in brown clay and silty matrix, fairly loosely compacted.
350-355	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as above except quartz grains more abundant. White fragments of felspar?
