355-360	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 330-335 above.
360-365	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 330-335 above.
365-370	<u>Silt</u> , light to medium brown and grey, coarsely textured, loosely compacted, common fine grains of clear, white, occasional orange, quartz set in light brown silty matrix, scattered orange silty inclusions and rare carbonaceous fragments.
370-375	<u>Silty sand</u> , clear, light brown, fine grained, medium to poorly sorted, sub-angular to sub-rounded quartz, very dirty, common brown and white silty interstitial material, scattered orange silty inclusions, minor number of grains stained orange - 1%.
375-380	<u>Sandy silt</u> , mid brown, clear, white, fine grained quartz set in clay and silt matrix, rare to scattered carbonaceous fragments, minor orange silt inclusions, loosely compacted.
380-385	<u>Silty sand</u> , clear, light brown, minor orange, very fine to medium grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted quartz, very dirty, common brown and white clayey and silty interstitial material, scattered white clay fragments, scattered to rare carbonaceous fragments, scattered yellow and orange clay inclusions, loosely compacted.
385-390	<u>Clayey sand</u> , as 380-385 above, except brown clay matrix more abundant.
390-395	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 380-385 above.
395-400	<u>Silty sand</u> , medium brown, clear and orange, very fine to fine grained, sub-angular to sub-rounded, medium to poorly sorted, quartz, very dirty, common brown and white silty interstitial material, common lithic white, yellow, orange and brown clay and silt particles, rare carbonaceous fragments, loosely compacted.
400-405	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 395-400 above.
405-410	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 395-400 above.
410-415	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 395-400 above.
415-420	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 395-400 above.
420-425	<u>Clay</u> , light grey, fine textured, moderately compacted.
425-430	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 415-420 above.
430-435	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 415-420 above.
435-440	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 415-420 above.
440-445	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 415-420 above.
445-450	<u>Silty mudstone</u> , medium grey, coarse textured, moderately compacted, scattered fine grained clear quartz and red, brown, white clay lithic fragments set in a medium grey matrix, rare scattered carbonaceous fragments.
450-455	<u>Silty mudstone</u> , as 445-450 above.
