90-95	<u>Mudstone</u> , medium to dark brown, medium textured, medium compacted, rare <u>finely</u> divided mica.
95-100	<u>Mudstone</u> , as 90-95 above.
100-105	<u>Mudstone</u> , as 90-95 above.
105-110	<u>Mudstone</u> , as 90-95 above. Rare, coarsely textured fragments scattered with clay fragments.
110-115	<u>Mudstone</u> , as 90-95 above.
115-120	<u>Mudstone</u> , as 90-95 above.
120-125	<u>Mudstone</u> , as 90-95 above.
125-230	<u>Mudstone</u> , as 90-95 above.
130-135	<u>Mudstone</u> , as 90-95 above. Coarse grains of black igneous rock?
135-140	<u>Mudstone</u> , as for 130-135 above.
140-145	<u>Mudstone</u> , as for 130-135 above.
145-150	<u>Mudstone</u> , dark brown, medium textured, moderately compacted, scattered light brown to orange silty inclusions, rare to scattered very dark brown pebbles of igneous material?
150-155	<u>Mudstone</u> , light brown to grey and medium brown, coarsely textured, scattered brown mineral? pebbles.
155-160	<u>Mudstone</u> , as for 130-135 above.
160-163	<u>Clayey sand</u> , fine grained to pebbly, sub-angular to sub-rounded, poorly sorted, smokey white, clear quartz, scattered black and brown igneous pebbles, minor light green metamorphic fragments (green soft mineral with metallic lustre) rare carbonaceous fragments, loosely compacted.
