## STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 165-170 Silty sand, medium grey, clear, fine grained, sub-angular to sub-rounded, medium to well sorted quartz, very dirty, common grey silty interstitial material, scattered minute carbonaceous specks, occasional white clay grains, loosely compacted.
- 170-175 Silty sand, as 165-170 above.
- 175-180 Silty sand, as 165-170 above, then a formation break to sand (pebbly) clear, grey smokey, very coarse grained and pebbly, sub-angular to angular, poorly sorted quartz, dirty, common light brown fine grained sandy and silty interstitial material, loosely compacted.
- 180-189 Sand, light brown, clear, smokey, very coarse grained, sub-angular to sub-rounded, medium sorted quartz, dirty, common light brown very fine grained sand and silty interstitial material, occasional orange staining of few quartz grains - less than 1% - loosely compacted.
- 185-190 Sand, as 180-185 above, except poorly sorted, angular to sub-rounded, rare to scattered carbonaceous fragments.
