

DEPTH	STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION
95-105	<u>Clay</u> , medium grey, medium textured, well compacted, scattered orange clay pebbles, scattered carbonaceous plant fragments
105-110	<u>Clay</u> , as 95-105 above.
110-115	<u>Clay</u> , as 95-105 above plus rare to scattered finely divided mica, and white clay inclusions.
115-120	<u>Clay</u> , as 95-105 above, except coarsely textured.
120-125	<u>Clay</u> , as 95-105 above.
125-130	<u>Clay</u> , as 95-105 above, except dark grey.
130-135	<u>Clay</u> , as 95-105 above, becoming more silty with scattered lithic fragments.
130-135	<u>Clay</u> , medium greyish brown, coarsely textured, well compacted, scattered orange silt blebs, carbonaceous fragments, rare mica.
135-140	<u>Clay</u> , as 130-135 above.
140-145	<u>Clay</u> , light to medium grey, occasional orange, medium textured, well compacted, scattered white minute soft clay inclusions.
145-150	<u>Clay</u> , medium brown, as 95-105 above.
150-155	<u>Clay</u> , light to medium grey, fine to medium textured, well compacted, scattered white and rust coloured clay inclusions, occasional loose coarsely grained quartz, rare minute carbonate specks.
155-160	<u>Clay</u> , medium dark brownish grey, fine textured, well compacted, rare minute carbonaceous specks.
160-165	<u>Clay</u> , as 155-160 above.
