STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 130-135 Silt, medium light brown and grey, rare carbonaceous grains, rare to scattered orange clay inclusions, coarsely textured, loosely compacted.
- 135-140 Silt, as 130-135 above, but common grey clay matrix, also stringers of medium grey clay.
- 140-145 Silt, light grey, scattered carbonaceous specks, scattered finely grained quartz, coarsely textured, loose to moderately compacted.
- 145-150 Silty clay, medium grey, scattered carbonaceous fragments and brown clay silt size grains, rare yellow clay, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 150-155 Silt, as 140 - 145 above.
- 155-160 Silt, medium to dark brown, minor orange, coarsely textured, moderately to loosely compacted.
- 160-165 Silt, as 155-160 above.
- 165-170 Silt, as 155 - 160 above, rare carbonaceous wood fragments.
- 170-175 Sandy silt, clear, light brown and yellow, silt to very finely grained, sub-angular to sub-rounded, poorly sorted quartz, scattered orange and white clay grains, set in a white and brown silty and clayey matrix, very coarsely textured, loosely compacted.
- 175-180 Silt, light brown and grey and white, coarsely textured, loosely compacted.
- 180-185 Silt, as 175-180 above, except medium brown and scattered carbonaceous wood fragments.
- 185-190 Silty clay, mid brown, coarsely textured, moderately compacted, scattered carbonaceous fragments.
- 195-200 Silty clay, as 185-190 above.
- 200-205 Clay, medium brown, scattered orange, medium to coarsely textured, loosely to moderately compacted, common brown and black carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered red and brown with yellowish orange coated sideritic clay inclusions.
- 205-210 Carbonaceous clay, as 200-205 above, scattered silt.
- 210-215 Carbonaceous clay, as 200-205 above, scattered silt.
- 215-220 Carbonaceous clay, as 200-205 above, scattered silt.
- 220-225 Clay, medium grey and brown, coarsely textured, loosely compacted, common carbonaceous material and wood fragments, scattered coarse grained, sub-rounded, orange silt particles, some of which are coated with yellow silt.limonite coated siderite.
- 225-230 Clay, light brown, yellow, orange, dark brown, grey and white, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
