STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

425-430	<u>Clayey silt</u> , as 420-425 above.
430-435 /sideritic	<u>Clay</u> , medium brown, white, yellow and orange stringers, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered reddish brown/clay grains, fine to medium textured, moderately compacted.
435-440 /sideritic	<u>Clay</u> , light to medium grey, white and yellow stringers, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered reddish brown/clay grains, fine to medium textured, well compacted.
440-445	<u>Clay</u> , as 435-440 above.
445-450	<u>Clay</u> , as 435-440 above.
450-455	<u>Clay</u> , as 435-440 above.
455-460	<u>Silty clay</u> , as 435-440 above.
460-465	<u>Clay</u> , as 435-440 above except orange, yellow, red and brown clay grains are more common.
465-470	<u>Clayey silt</u> , medium brown, white, yellow and orange stringers, scattered multicoloured clay particles, scattered fine to medium grains of quartz, medium textured, moderately compacted.
