STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 135-140 Sand, clear, white, smokey, grey and brown, rare purple, fine to very coarsely grained, sub-angular to sub-rounded (some angular quartz broken up by drilling) quartz, rare quartzite, grey indurated silt, rare carbonaceous fragments, clean, rare to scattered fragments of dark igneous rock, occasional orange and yellow stained aggregates of sand, stained grains are less than 3%, loosely compacted, rare to scattered silty interstitial material.
- 140-145 Sand, as for 135-140 above, scattered pebbles of quartz up to 1/4" diameter.
- 145-150 Sand, as 135-140 above.
- 155-160 Silty clay, medium grey and brown, coarsely textured, loosely to moderately compacted, common finely grained, clear, brown and grey quartz.
