## STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 115-120 Pebbly silty clay, as 110-115 above, occasional pebbles of orange siltstone, pink granite with quartz and pink felspar pebbles becoming more common.
- 120-125 Silty clay, medium brown, loosely to medium compacted, silt size grains as in 110-115 above, scattered clear, white, sub-rounded quartz pebbles up to 1/8" diameter.
- 125-130 Clay, medium brown, coarsely textured, loosely consolidated, silt size grains as 110-115 above, scattered clear, white poorly sorted, sub-rounded to rounded quartz pebbles up to 1/4" diameter, occasional pink felspar.
- 130-135 Silty clay, medium brown, silt size, clear, white and brown, sub-angular, medium sorted quartz, scattered finely divided mica, scattered orange and rusty brown soft clay mineral, minute scattered carbonaceous fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted, scattered pebbles of quartz, white, clear, and granite with felspar.
- 135-140 Silty clay, as 130-135 above, except pebbles more common.
- 140-145 Silty clay, as 130-135 above, except quartz pebbles are more sub-angular to angular.
- 145-150 Silty clay, as 130-135 above.
- 150-145 Silty clay, as 130-135 above.
- 145-150 Silty clay, as 130-135 above.
- 150-155 Silty clay, as 130-135 above.
- 155-160 Silty clay, medium brown, moderately compacted; coarsely textured, silt size grains of white, brown, grey and orange quartz and clay, rare to scattered minute carbonaceous specks, scattered pebbles up to 1/8" diameter of clear and white quartz, granite?, light grey siltstone, rare fine mica.
- 160-165 Silty clay, as 155-160 above, except pink felspar rounded pebbles, minor rusty clay specks.
- 165-170 Silty clay, as 155-160 above.
- 170-175 Silty clay, as 155-160 above.
- 175-180 Silty clay, as 155-160 above, but pebbles rare, carbonaceous blebs and lignite fragments up to 1/8" sometimes present, (less than 1%).
- 180-185 Silty clay, medium brown, moderately compacted, medium textured, silt grains composed of brown, grey, white and orange quartz, scattered finely divided mica, rare to scattered carbonaceous fragments 1/16" diameter, rare well rounded quartz pebbles.
- 185-190 Silty clay, as 180-185 above, except scattered clear and white quartz pebbles up to 1/8" diameter, some red clay pebbles.
