

DEPTH	STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION
70-75	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 65-70 plus scattered mica.
75-80	<u>Silty sand</u> , clear, occasional light brown, silt size to finely grained, sub-angular, medium-well sorted, quartz, very dirty, common white clayey interstitial material, rare carbonaceous specks, loosely compacted.
80-85	<u>Silty clay</u> , medium to dark grey, scattered very fine dirty mica and rare minute carbonaceous specks, scattered white clay grains, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
85-90	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 75-80 above.
90-95	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 75-80 above.
95-100	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 75-80 above, rare orange specks and rare mica.
100-105	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 65-70 above, occasional yellow-orange stringers.
105-110	<u>Silty sand</u> , light grey, clear, white light brown, silt size to finely grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted quartz, very dirty, common light grey and white silty and clayey interstitial material, scattered white clay grains, occasional brown-black well rounded ferruginous? pebbles up to 1/16" in diameter.
110-115	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 105-110 above.
115-120	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 105-110 above.
120-125	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 105-110 above.
125-130	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 105-110 above, scattered to rare medium yellow-brown silt lenses, bright reddish orange ferruginous shale inclusions, scattered coarsely grained quartz.
130-135	<u>Sandy silt</u> , medium grey, common fine-very coarse grains of quartz, rare carbonaceous specks, rare medium reddish-brown nodules.
135-140	<u>Clay</u> , light grey, light yellowish brown, orange, minor white, scattered coarse grains of quartz and rare reddish brown nodules, rare carbonaceous wood fragments, medium textured, moderately compacted.
140-145	<u>Clay</u> , white minor orange and yellow, scattered coarse grains of quartz, finely textured, moderately compacted.
145-150	<u>Clay and silt</u> , white and yellow stringers, scattered fine-coarse grains of quartz, medium-coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
150-155	<u>Clay</u> , as 140-145 above.
155-160	<u>Sandy clay</u> , white, minor orange, common coarse grains of angular quartz, coarsely textured, loosely to moderately compacted.
160-165	<u>Clay</u> , orange, medium brown, yellow, white, stringers and streaks, scattered medium-coarse quartz grains, rare brown and purplish brown nodules of clay, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
