STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 255-260 Silt, medium brown and white stringers, scattered clay stringers as clay in 250-255 above, rare orange patches, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, rare, reddish-brown sideritic clusters or nodules, finely to medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 260-265 Sandy Silt, light grey, scattered medium grey clay lenses, rare sideritic clay fragments, rare carbonaceous wood fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 265-270 Clay, medium grey, scattered yellow stringers, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay fragments, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 270-275 Clay, medium brown, light grey, scattered orange stringers, scattered silt and finely grained sand lenses, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay clusters and inclusions, finely to medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 275-280 Clay, as 270-275 above
- 280-285 Clay, as 270-275 above
- 285-290 Clay, as 270-275 above
- 290-295 Clay as 270-275 above
- 295-300 Clay, light brown and grey, scattered orange inclusions, rare to scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, rare reddish-brown sideritic nodules, medium-textured, moderately compacted.
- 305-310 Clay, as 295-300 above
- 310-315 Clay, medium grey and brown, orange and light grey stringers, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered reddish-brown sideritic nodules, limonitic-coated ferruginous nodules, finely to medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 315-320 Clay, as 310-315 above.
- 320-325 Clay, medium grey, scattered orange and rare yellow stringers, scattered small reddish-brown sideritic clay nodules and grains, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 325-330 Clay, as 320-325 above.
- 330-335 Clay, and 320-325 above
- 335-340 Clay, medium brown and grey, white to light grey, scattered orange clay inclusions, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered red-brown and orange sideritic clusters or nodules and inclusions, scattered finely-grained clear quartz grains, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 340-345 Clay, as 335-340 above.
- 345-350 Clay, light to medium grey, scattered orange siderite nodules and limonitic-coated sideritic clay inclusions.
