90-95	<u>Clay</u> , as 85-90 above.
95-100	<u>Clay</u> , as 80-85 above.
100-105	<u>Clay</u> , as 80-85 above.
105-110	<u>Clay</u> , dark brown, medium brown stringers of finely textured silt, scattered inclusions and blebs of white, yellow and orange silt, scattered finely divided mica, scattered carbonaceous, medium textured, well compacted.
110-115	<u>Clay</u> , dark brown, scattered inclusions and lenses of orange-brown clay, rare finely divided mica, medium textured, well compacted.
115-120	<u>Clay</u> , as 105-110 above.
120-125	<u>Clay</u> , as 105-110 above, scattered medium brown clay, occasional pink and orange-red stained coarse grained quartz and pebbles up to 1/16" diameter, medium textured, well compacted.
125-130	<u>Clay</u> , medium and dark brown clay, fine to medium textured, well compacted.
130-135	Missing.
135-140	<u>Clay</u> , as 125-130 above, rare orange clay inclusions.
140-145	<u>Clay</u> , dark and medium brown, scattered yellow, orange and white inclusions, scattered black carbonaceous mud? scattered clear glassy quartz fragments (cavings?) finely textured, moderately compacted.
145-150	<u>Clay</u> , dark brown, rare white to light brown, coarsely textured, silt lenses, finely textured, moderately compacted.
150-155	<u>Clay</u> , as 145-150 above, silt stringers, scattered to common.
155-160	<u>Interbedded clay and silt</u> as 150-155 above. Silt tends to grade into a finely grained sand in places.
160-165	<u>Interbedded clay and silt</u> , as 155-160 above, except scattered yellowish brown clay stringers.
165-170	<u>Sandy silt</u> , light grey, scattered finely to medium clear quartz grains set in a white silty and clayey matrix, coarsely textured, loosely compacted.
170-175	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as above, except quartz fine to coarsely grained, scattered very finely grained dark mineral? grains.
175-180	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 170-175 above.
180-185	<u>Sandy silt</u> , as 170-175 above, plus scattered pebbles of white quartz up to 1/2" diameter, and grey quartzite, occasional carbonaceous wood fragments.
185-190	<u>Clay</u> , mottled medium brown, orange, yellow and white, scattered clear medium to coarsely grained quartz, medium textured, moderately compacted.
