STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 345-350 Clay, as 340-345 above, occasional quartz pebbles.
- 350-355 Clay, mottled as 340-345 above.
- 355-360 Clay, medium brown, light brown, white, yellow, orange, mottled, common carbonaceous wood fragments and material, scattered pebbles up to 1/8" diameter of clear and smokey quartz, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 365-370 Clay, as 360-365 above.
- 370-375 Silty clay, white to light grey, scattered stringers of yellow clay, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 375-380 Silty clay, as 370-375 above, occasional medium brown clay nodules.
- 380-385 Clay, white to light grey, occasional light pink tinge, rare to scattered yellowish brown clay inclusions, medium textured, loosely to moderately compacted.
- 385-390 Clay, as 380-385 above, occasional ferruginous black shale platy fragments, rare red and brown silt lenses.
- 390-395 Clay, as 380-385 above, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments.
- 395-400 Clay, as 385-390 above.
- 400-410 Clay, as 385-390 above, scattered medium brown and orange clay lenses.
- 410-415 Clay, mottled medium brown, white, rare orange stringers, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments and material.
