- STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION -

- 100-105 Calcareous Silt, as 95-100 but becoming sandier.
- 105-110 Sandy Clay, and silt, light brown, white, orange, common fine grained quartz and reddish brown siderite grains, scattered quartzite and quartz pebbles up to 1/8" in diameter, scattered carbonaceous-wood fragments, rare slightly calcareous silt patches, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 110-115 Sandy Clay and Silt, as 105-110 above.
- 115-120 Sandy Silt, as 105-110 above, slightly calcareous.
- 120-125 Clay, light to medium grey and brown, rare to scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered pebbles of quartz and quartzite up to 1/8" diameter, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay inclusions and nodule clusters, fine to medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 125-130 Clay, medium brown and white, scattered reddish brown siderite nodules, rare carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered angular fragments of quartz and quartzite, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 130-135 Clay, as 125-130 above.
- 135-140 Clay, as 125-130 above, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments.
- 140-145 Silt, light greenish grey speckled orange, scattered medium brown stringers, scattered magnetitic shale fragments, scattered carbonaceous-wood fragments, medium to coarse textured, moderately compacted.
- 145-150 Clay, light and medium brown and grey, scattered white, yellow and orange streaks and inclusions, scattered orange, sideritic clay inclusions and siderite nodules, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 150-155 Clay, light brown, grey and yellow, streaks and stringers, scattered fine grained siderite grains, rare to scattered pebbles of quartz and quartzite up to 1/16" diameter, fine to medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 155-160 Clay, light brown with fawn and yellow streaks scattered orange fine grained siderite grains, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 160-165 Clay, medium to dark brown, light fawn, rare white and orange, stringers, lenses and inclusions, scattered light grey silt lenses, scattered orange siderite grain clusters, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 165-170 Clay, 155-160 above.
- 170-175 Clay, as 155-160 above, but coarsely textured.
- 175-180 Clay, as 155-160 above, scattered reddish brown sideritic clay inclusions.
- 189-185 Silt, light brown with white and orange patches, scattered carbonaceous blebs, and wood fragments, scattered fine to medium quartz grains, medium to coarse textured, moderately compacted.
- 185-190 Clay, light to medium grey, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered fine grained quartz, scattered reddish brown sideritic clay fragments, fine to medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 190-195 Clay, as 185-190 above.
