215-220	<u>Clay</u> , medium brown, scattered orange patches, scattered medium brown sideritic clay inclusions, rare medium grained quartz, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
220-225	<u>Clay</u> , as 215-220 above.
225-230	<u>Silt</u> , light to medium brown, scattered orange patches, scattered fine to medium quartz grains, rare angular quartz fragments, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, medium textured, moderately compacted.
230-235	<u>Silt</u> , as 225-230 above, but sandier.
235-240	<u>Silt</u> , light grey, brown and orange, scattered reddish brown sideritic clay fragments, scattered carbonaceous wood fragment, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
240-245	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , light to medium grey, fine to medium grained quartz, scattered, carbonaceous wood fragments, coarsely textured, loosely to moderately compacted.
245-250	<u>Silty Sand</u> , clear, light brown, fine to coarse grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted quartz, extremely dirty, common light brown and grey silty and white clayey interstitial material, common orange siderite grains and clusters, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, moderately to loosely compacted.
250-255	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 245-250 above.
255-260	<u>Silt</u> , medium brown, scattered white lenses and rare orange inclusions, scattered medium grained quartz, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
260-265	<u>Silt</u> , as 255-260 above.
265-270	<u>Silt</u> , as 255-260 above, becoming very sandy.
270-275	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 240-245 above.
275-280	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , light grey and brown, common fine to very coarse grained quartz, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered ferruginous shale plates, scattered angular quartz fragments, coarsely textured, grades into silty sand in places, loosely to moderately compacted.
280-285	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 275-280 above.
285-290	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 275-280 above.
