STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 100-105 Clay, light to medium orange, brown and yellow, rare white inclusions, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered pebbles of quartz, quartzite and dolerite up to ¼" diameter, finely textured, moderately compacted.
- 105-110 Sandy Silt, medium brown, scattered white lenses and stringers, rare yellow clay inclusions, medium to very coarse grained quartz and pebbles of quartzite, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay inclusions and fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 110-115 Sandy Silt, as 105-110 above, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments.
- 115-120 Sandy Silt, as 105-110 above.
- 120-125 Clayey Sand, clear, light brown, light green, rare pink, fine to coarsely grained, sub-angular to sub-rounded, poorly sorted, quartz, extremely dirty, common light brown and white clayey interstitial material, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, rare yellow staining on a few grains, loosely to moderately compacted.
- 125-130 Sandy Silt, as 105-110, common clay matrix.
