

DEPTH	STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION
105-110	<u>Clay</u> , as 100-105 above, occasional pebbly inclusions of hard dark brown clay.
110-115	<u>Clay</u> , as 100-105 above.
115-120	<u>Clay</u> , red, rare white clay inclusions, rare fine grains of quartz, finely textured, moderately compacted (plastic).
120-125	<u>Clay</u> , light brown, waxy, scattered yellow and pink clay inclusions, scattered dark brown clay, sub-rounded grains, finely textured, well compacted.
125-130	<u>Clay</u> , as 120-125 above, scattered pebbles of up to 1/2" diameter of hard indurated brown silt and clay and quartz, medium textured, well compacted.
130-135	<u>Sandy silt</u> , medium to light grey and brown, clear, silt size and very fine grains of quartz set in white and light grey silt matrix, occasional yellow and white clay inclusions, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, friable, loosely compacted, coarsely textured.
135-140	<u>Pebbly clay</u> , rounded, coarse grains and pebbles up to 1/8" diameter of grey sub-rounded clay set in a medium brown coarsely textured clay matrix, rare sub-rounded coarse grains of quartz.
140-145	<u>Clay</u> , medium brown, coarsely textured to silty, loosely compacted, scattered yellow and white clay inclusions, occasional carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered sub-rounded quartz.
145-150	<u>Clay</u> , as 140-145 above.
150-155	<u>Clay</u> , medium to light brown, minor white, orange and pink, scattered black and white igneous fragments, occasional quartz grains, coarsely textured, loosely to moderately compacted.
155-160	<u>Clay</u> , as 150-155 above.
160-165	<u>Silty clay</u> , light grey, coarsely textured, loosely to moderately compacted, scattered minute carbonaceous fragments, scattered clear fine grains of quartz.
165-170	<u>Clay</u> , light grey, light brown, minor white, scattered black igneous fragments, scattered orange and pink clay inclusions, moderately compacted, coarsely textured, sometimes silty.
170-175	<u>Clay</u> , medium brown and grey, as above 165-170.
175-180	<u>Silty clay</u> , medium brown and grey, minor orange, white inclusions, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments and soft carbonaceous mud?
180-185	<u>Silty clay</u> , medium brown and grey, minor orange, yellow and red, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, occasional black igneous fragments, scattered inclusions of multicoloured clay pebbles, rare fine grains of quartz, coarsely textured, loosely to moderately compacted.
