| 185-190 | <u>Clay</u> , medium brown, yellow, white, orange and red, scattered angular fragments of igneous rock, rare rounded fine grains of grey and brown clay, medium textured, moderately compacted. |
| 190-195 | <u>Clay</u> , as 185-190 above.   |
| 195-200 | <u>Clay</u> , as 185-190 above.   |
| 200-210 | <u>Clay</u> , as 185-190 above.   |
| 210-215 | <u>Clay</u> , as 185-190 above.   |
