## STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 145-150 Sandy Clay, light and medium brown, orange, minor red and white inclusions, common carbonaceous matter and wood fragments, common fine to coarsely grained quartz, coarsely textured, moderately to loosely compacted.
- 150-155 Clay, medium grey and brown, scattered orange, yellow and white lenses and inclusions, occasional reddish-brown sideritic clay inclusions, finely textured, moderately compacted.
- 155-160 Sand, clear, medium to coarse grained, sub-rounded, poorly sorted, quartz, dirty common light brown and orange clayey interstitial material, scattered stringers of orange, white and dark brown clay, scattered angular quartz fragments, scattered carbonaceous matter, loosely to moderately compacted.
- 160-165 Clay, light, medium and dark brown, scattered orange stringers, scattered lenses of white silt and sand, scattered carbonaceous matter and wood fragments, scattered pebbles of quartz and quartzite up to 1/16" in diameter, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 165-170 Sandy Clay, light, medium, dark brown, orange, yellow and white stringers, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered silt lenses, scattered fine to medium quartz grains, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 170-175 Clay, medium to dark brown and grey, white, orange scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered reddish brown sideritic clay inclusions, scattered pebbles of quartz up to 1/8" in diameter, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 175-180 Clay, mottled light, medium grey and brown, white, yellow, orange, scattered carbonaceous matter, and wood fragments, scattered very coarse grains of quartz, coarsely textured, loosely to moderately compacted.
- 180-185 Clay, as 175-180 above.
- 185-190 Clay, as 175-180 above, becoming sandy.
- 190-195 Sand, clear, scattered orange and rare yellow, fine to coarse grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted, quartz, dirty, common light brown, yellow, orange and rare red silty interstitial material, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered reddish brown minute sideritic grains, about 20% of grains have reddish, orange and rare yellow staining.
- 195-200 Sandy Silt, medium brown, common fine to coarse grains of quartz, scattered carbonaceous-wood fragments, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay inclusions, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 200-205 Clay, medium grey and brown, orange and yellow, rare white stringers, lenses and inclusions, scattered carbonaceous-wood fragments, scattered medium grained quartz, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay inclusions, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 205-210 Clay, as 200-205 above.
- 210-215 Clay, as 200-205 above.
