STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

340-345	<u>Silty Clay</u> , as 335-340 above, scattered patches of mottled orange and white clay.
345-350	<u>Silty Clay</u> , as 335-340 above, only mottled.
350-355	<u>Silty Clay</u> , as 345-350 above.
355-360	<u>Silty Clay</u> , as 345-350 above.
360-365	<u>Silty Clay</u> , mottled medium-dark brown, orange, white, yellow, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered reddish brown siderite nodule clusters, rare pebbles and angular fragments of quartz up to 1/16" diameter, coarsely textured, grades into silt in places, moderately compacted.
365-370	<u>Silty Clay</u> , as 360-365 above.
370-375	<u>Silty Clay</u> , as 360-365 above.
375-380	<u>Silty Clay</u> , as 360-365 above, slightly calcareous.
380-385	<u>Silty Clay</u> , as 360-365 above.
385-390	<u>Clay</u> , mottled medium, dark, greyish brown, orange, white and rare yellow, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
390-395	<u>Clay</u> , as 385-390 above.
395-400	<u>Clay</u> , as 385-390 above, rare carbonaceous wood fragments.
400-405	<u>Clay</u> , as 395-400 above.
405-410	<u>Clay</u> , as 385-390 above, common medium to very coarse grained and pebbles of rounded quartz, rare reddish brown siderite nodule clusters.
410-415	<u>Clay</u> , as 405-410 above.
415-420	<u>Clay</u> , as 405-410 above, common orange clay.
420-425	<u>Clay</u> , medium grey and brown stringers, scattered orange inclusions, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered medium brown sideritic clay fragments, and siderite nodule clusters, scattered medium to coarse grains of loose quartz, medium textured, moderately compacted.
425-430	<u>Clay</u> , mottled medium to dark grey, white, pink, orange, rare yellow, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered reddish brown sideritic silt fragments and siderite nodule clusters, scattered brown, sub-rounded, fine coarsely grained quartz, with occasional orange straining, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
430-435	<u>Clay</u> , as 425-430 above.
435-440	<u>Clay</u> , as 425-430 above, predominantly orange coloured.
440-445	<u>Clay</u> , as 425-430 above, predominately white coloured.
445-450	<u>Clay</u> , as 425-430 above.
450-455	<u>Clay</u> , mottled pink, orange, yellow, medium and dark brown, white, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, rare to scattered sideritic clay inclusions and nodules, rare coarse grains of brown quartz, medium to finely textured, moderately compacted.
455-460	<u>Clay</u> , as 425-430 above.
460-465	<u>Clay</u> , as 425-430 above.
465-470	<u>Clay</u> , as 425-430 above.
470-475	<u>Clay</u> , as 425-430 above.
