STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 255-260 Clay, as 240-245 above, scattered patches of reddish-orange and yellow, scattered medium brown clay stringers.
- 260-265 Clay, mottled white, fawn, brown, grey orange and yellow scattered yellow limonitic shale fragments, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered red-brown siderite nodule clusters, scattered coarse grains of quartz, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 265-270 Sandy Clay, white, medium brown, with patches of orange, common fine to coarse grains of quartz, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered medium grey clay stringers, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 270-275 Clay, medium brown, scattered white silt stringers, scattered bone coloured clay inclusions, scattered bright coal fragments, rare mica, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 275-280 Silt, medium brown, orange-brown, white stringers, rare coarsely grained quartz, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 280-285 Clay, dark brown, orange, scattered white silt lenses, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 285-290 Clay, as 250-255 above.
- 290-295 Clay, as 250-255 above.
- 295-300 Clay, dark, medium and orange-brown, scattered white to very light fawn stringers, finely textured, plastic, moderately compacted.
- 300-305 Clay, dark brown, medium brown, orange stringers, scattered white silt lenses, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 305-310 Clay, as 290-295 above.
- 310-315 Clay, dark brown, rare orange inclusions, scattered white silt stringers, scattered very coarse grains of quartz, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 315-320 Clay, as 310-315 above, except medium brown.
- 320-325 Clay, medium brown, minor orange and white streaks and patches, scattered white silt lenses, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered medium to coarse grains of quartz, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 325-330 Clay, dark brown, orange-brown, scattered orange streaks and inclusions, scattered yellow and orange silt lenses, occasional very coarse grains of quartz, finely textured, moderately compacted. (Orange clay patches look ferruginous in places.)
- 330-335 Clay, as 325-330 above.
- 335-340 Clay, medium brown, scattered orange (ferruginous?) tinges and patches, rare to scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 340-345 Clay, as 335-340 above, scattered white silt lenses.
- 345-350 Clay, medium to dark brown, scattered orange streaks and stringers, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 350-355 Clay, as 345-350 above.
