STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 355-360 Clay, as 345-350 above.
- 360-365 Silt, white and medium brown interbeds, scattered reddish brown sideritic clay inclusions, scattered orange clay inclusions, and streaks, rare medium grains of quartz, rare silvery grey metallic rosette (pyrite?), medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 365-370 Silt, as 350-365 above, pyrite?
- 370-375 Silt, as 360-365 above.
- 375-380 Silt, as 360-365 above, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, rare mica.
- 380-385 Silt, as 375-380 above.
- 385-390 Clay, medium brown, white, scattered orange lenses, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments and matter, rare to scattered reddish-brown silt stringers, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 390-395 Clay, as 385-390 above, scattered very coarse grains of quartz, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay inclusions.
- 395-400 Sand, clear fine to very coarse grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted, quartz, very dirty, common, light brown silty and occasional orange and yellow ferruginous? interstitial patches, rare carbonaceous-wood fragments, common reddish-orange sideritic nodules, clusters and grains, scattered white and brown clay inclusions, moderately compacted.
- 400-405 Silt, white, light brown, scattered orange patches, scattered sandy lenses, scattered carbonaceous-wood fragments, scattered reddish brown ferruginous clay fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 405-410 Silt, as 400-405 above.
- 410-415 Silt, as 400-405 above, fine to medium textured.
- 415-420 Silt, as 400-405 above, scattered to common medium to dark brown, white, orange clay stringers.
- 420-425 Silt, as 415-420 above.
- 425-430 Silt, as 415-420 above.
- 430-435 Silt, as 400-405 above.
- 435-440 Silt, white, light brown, light grey, scattered yellow and orange, purple specks and patches, scattered lenses, medium grey clay, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 440-445 Silt, as 435-440 above.
- 445-450 Silt, as 435-440 above.
- 450-455 Silt, light brown, scattered white and rare orange patches, becomes sandy in some patches, scattered fine to coarse grains of quartz, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 455-460 Silt, as 450-455 above, scattered carbonaceous-wood fragments.
