STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 108
- 0-5 Sandy Silt, very light fawn, common clear, minor light brown and rare orange, finely grained, poorly sorted quartz, set in silty matrix, scattered light brown and pink quartz pebbles up to 1/16" diameter, most of finely grained quartz have slight orange staining, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 5-10 Sandy Silt, as 0-5 above, becoming more clayey, scattered fragments of quartzite.
- 10-15 Clay, mottled yellow, orange-brown, white, silty in places, scattered quartzite and quartz pebbles and fragments up to 1/4" diameter, scattered limonitic clay nodules, rare carbonaceous wood fragments, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted
- 15-20 Clay, as 10-15 above.
- 20-25 Clay, light fawn, scattered light bluish-grey stringers, scattered dark brown ferruginous fragments, rare small carbonaceous wood fragments, rare medium grained light brown quartz, finely textured, moderately compacted.
- 25-30 Clay, medium orange-brown, rare bluish-grey and medium brown stringers, rare small carbonaceous wood fragments, plastic, finely textured, moderately compacted.
- 30-35 Clay, very dark brown and light medium tan to orange stringers, plastic, finely textured, moderately compacted.
- 35-40 Clay, medium orange-brown, scattered bluish-grey and dark brown stringers, plastic, finely textured, moderately compacted.
- 40-45 Clay, as 30-35 above, medium textured.
- 45-50 Clay, as 40-45 above.
- 50-55 Clay, as 30-35 above, scattered yellowish-orange silt stringers.
- 55-60 Clay, dark chocolate brown, scattered white, light fawn, orange lenses and inclusions, scattered white silt patches, scattered carbonaceous mud inclusions, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 60-65 Clay, medium grey, common interbeds and stringers of medium fawn and white and rare orange clay, finely to medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 65-70 Clay, as 60-65 above.
- 70-75 Clay, as 60-65 above, white and orange stringers becoming more abundant.
- 75-80 Clay, medium grey, one rounded pebble up to 3/4" diameter of white hard clay, finely textured, moderately compacted.
- 80-85 Clay, white scattered medium grey stringers, coarsely textured, moderately to well compacted.
- 85-90 Clay, as 80-85 above.
- 90-95 Clay, as 60-65 above, rare angular fragments of light brown to pink quartzite, rare reddish-brown ferruginous clay.
- 95-100 Clay, medium grey, scattered white and rare orange and brown stringers, rare carbonaceous blebs, scattered orange-brown limonitic clay inclusions and reddish-brown ferruginous clay inclusions, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
