

DEPTH	STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION
270-275	<u>Silty Sand</u> , as 265-270 above, occasional yellow clay inclusions.
275-280	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 255-260 above.
280-285	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 255-260 above.
285-290	<u>Sand</u> , clear, scattered orange, fine to coarse grained, sub-angular to sub-rounded, medium to poorly sorted, quartz, very dirty, common light brown silty interstitial material, scattered orange silt lenses, and white clay grains, scattered to rare carbonaceous wood fragments, angular pebble up to 1/4" diameter of iron stained white quartzite, rare very slight orange and pink staining of about 2% of the quartz grains, loosely to moderately compacted.
290-295	<u>Sand</u> , as 285-290 above.
295-300	<u>Sand</u> , as 285-290 above, but fine to medium grained, medium to well sorted and not as dirty.
300-305	<u>Sand</u> , clear, rare pink and orange, fine grained, sub-angular to sub-rounded, medium to well sorted quartz, fairly clean, scattered, light brown silty and white clayey interstitial material, rare reddish-brown ferruginous patches, scattered carbonaceous grains, friable, loosely compacted, about 5% of the grains have slight orange staining.
305-310	<u>Sand</u> , as 300-305 above.
310-315	<u>Sand</u> , as 300-305 above.
315-320	<u>Sand</u> , clear, rare orange, fine to coarse grained, sub-angular to sub-rounded, poorly sorted, quartz, very dirty common light fawn silty and white clayey interstitial material, scattered carbonaceous grains, and white and light grey clay grains, about 2% of quartz is slightly orange stained, friable, loosely compacted.
320-325	<u>Sand</u> , as 315-320 above.
325-330	<u>Sand</u> , as 315-320 above, but fine to very coarse grained, and not so dirty.
330-335	<u>Sand</u> , as 315-320 above.
335-340	<u>Sand</u> , clear, minor light brown and orange, fine to medium grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted, quartz, very dirty common light brown silty interstitial material, scattered stringers of sandy silt, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments and specks, rare orange and yellow silty patches, rare slight orange staining of a few quartz grains, loosely to moderately compacted.
340-345	<u>Sand</u> , clear, medium, occasional coarse grained, sub-angular to sub-rounded, medium sorted, quartz, dirty, common light brown silty interstitial material, scattered white, light grey and orange clay grains and inclusions, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments and fairly dirty carbonaceous matter between the quartz grains like gilsonite (dead oil), about 5% of the grains have black (carbonaceous matter) staining and about 2% have orange staining, loosely to moderately compacted.
