STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 345-350 Sand, as 340-345 above, only very dirty and scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay inclusions and rare rounded light grey hard silicified silt pebble up to 1/4" diameter.
- 350-355 Sand, clear, scattered light brown, fine to coarse grained, occasional pebbles up to 1/16" diameter, sub-angular, medium sorted, quartz, very dirty, common light brown and scattered orange silty interstitial material, common carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered stringers of orange-brown, orange clay, loosely to moderately compacted.
- 355-360 Clay, light to medium grey and orange stringers, scattered white and orange inclusions, sandy, scattered fine grained quartz, rare to scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 360-365 Clay, as 355-360 above, except common white clay lenses and inclusions.
- 365-370 Clay, light medium grey, white, light fawn, orange stringers and inclusions, coarsely textured, becoming silty in places, moderately compacted.
- 370-375 Clay, as 365-370 above, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments.
- 375-380 Clay, as 365-370 above, except finely textured, rare angular quartz fragments.
- 380-385 Clay, mottled, light and medium grey, white fawn, yellow and orange, scattered, sub-angular, pebbles of quartz and quartzite, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 385-390 Clay, as 380-385 above.
- 390-395 Sand, clear, minor light brown, fine to very coarse grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted, quartz, dirty, common light brown silty interstitial material, scattered angular fragments of quartz and quartzite, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered interbeds and stringers of medium grey and orange clay, moderately compacted.
- 395-400 Sandy Silt, light brown, common fine to very coarse grained quartz, scattered orange patches, common carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered pebbles of quartz up to 1/16" diameter, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 400-405 Sandy Silt, as 395-400 above, becoming less sandy.
- 405-410 Sandy Silt, as 395-400 above, scattered orange and white clay lenses.
- 410-415 Sandy Silt, as 395-400 above, common yellow and orange patches.
- 415-420 Sandy Silt, as 395-400 above, grading into a silty sand.
- 420-425 Silty Sand, clear, fine grained, sub-angular, medium sorted, quartz, very dirty, common light grey and scattered orange silty interstitial material, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay fragments, loosely to moderately compacted.
