

DEPTH	STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION
425-430	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , light brown and grey, white, scattered yellow and orange, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered fragments of quartz and sideritic clay, minor limonitic stained patches, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
430-435	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 425-430 above.
435-440	<u>Silty Sand</u> , as 420-425 above.
440-445	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 425-430 above.
445-450	<u>Silty Clay</u> , mottled, light brown, grey and orange, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered fragments of reddish brown sideritic clay, pebbles of quartz and quartzite and broken angular quartz fragments, occasional limonitic staining, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
450-455	<u>Silty Sand</u> , clear, minor light brown, fine to very coarse grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted, quartz extremely dirty, common light brown, scattered yellow and rare orange silty interstitial material, scattered yellow and orange and minor white clay lenses, scattered to rare carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered clear quartz pebbles up to 1/8" diameter, rare slight orange and yellow staining of a few grains, loosely to moderately compacted.
455-460	<u>Silty Sand</u> , as 450-455 above, becoming very pebbly.
460-465	<u>Silty Sand</u> , as 450-455 above, becoming very pebbly, rare to scattered reddish brown sideritic clay fragments.
465-470	<u>Silty Sand</u> , as 460-465 above, predominantly very coarse grained.
470-475	<u>Silty Sand</u> , as 465-470 above, sideritic clay fragments are more common.
475-480	<u>Silty Sand</u> , clear minor light brown and yellow, medium to coarse grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted, quartz, very dirty, common light brown and white and occasional orange silty interstitial material, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, rare slight orange and yellow staining of a very few grains, loosely to moderately compacted.
480-485	<u>Silty Sand</u> , as 450-455 above, but predominantly coarse grained.
485-490	<u>Silty Sand</u> , as 450-455 above, but predominantly coarse grained.
490-495	<u>Silty Sand</u> , as 450-455 above, but predominantly coarse grained.
