255-260	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> 85%; and clay as 250-255 above, rare orange limonitic clay fragments and reddish-brown sideritic clay fragments.
260-265	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 80%; and clay as 255-260 above.
265-270	<u>Clay</u> , medium and light grey and fawn, common carbonaceous wood fragments 45%, scattered angular fragments of reddish-brown sideritic clay, scattered limonitic clay nodules, scattered fragments of quartz and quartzite, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
270-275	<u>Clay</u> , as 265-270 above, scattered white tuff?
275-280	<u>Clay</u> , as 270-275 above, except carbonaceous wood fragments 75%
280-285	<u>Clay</u> , as 275-280 above.
285-290	<u>Clay</u> , as 275-280 above.
290-295	<u>Clay</u> , as 275-280 above.
295-300	<u>Clay</u> , as 275-280 above.
300-305	<u>Sand</u> , clear, light brown, scattered smokey, rare yellow, fine to coarse grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted, quartz, fairly clean, scattered light brown silty interstitial material, common siderite grains and nodules, scattered orange limonitic sandy clay, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, rare platy lemon shale? fragments, scattered fragments of reddish-brown sideritic clay, about 20% of quartz has slight orange limonitic staining, friable, loosely compacted.
305-310	<u>Sand</u> , as 300-305 above, but generally fine to medium grained.
310-315	<u>Silt</u> , light grey, sandy in patches, common carbonaceous wood fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
315-320	<u>Silt</u> , as 310-315 above, scattered orange patches, carbonaceous wood fragments 60%
320-325	<u>Silt</u> , light grey and fawn, scattered very coarse grained, sub-angular, clear quartz, and rare fragments of quartzite, scattered to common carbonaceous wood fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
325-330	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , light grey and fawn, white and rare patches of orange, common carbonaceous wood fragments, common very coarse grained white, clear and light brown, sub-angular, quartz, rare reddish-brown sideritic clay fragments, coarsely textured, loosely to moderately compacted.
330-335	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 325-330 above, carbonaceous wood fragments 30%
335-340	<u>Silty Sand</u> , clear, light brown, white, fine to very coarse grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted, quartz, very dirty, common, light brown, orange, yellow and white silty and clayey interstitial material, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered slight orange limonitic staining of about 20% quartz grains.
