

DEPTH	STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION
340-345	<u>Silty Sand</u> , as 335-340 above.
345-350	<u>Sand</u> , clear, light brown, white, fine to medium grained, sub-angular, medium sorted, quartz, dirty, common light brown and orange limonitic silty and clayey interstitial material, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, occasional very coarse grained quartz, loosely to moderately compacted.
350-355	<u>Sand</u> , as 345-350 above, orange limonitic clay is more common.
355-360	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 95%, clay light grey, scattered medium grained, quartz.
360-365	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 90%, clay bright orange, light brownish-grey, scattered fragments, very coarse grained, clear and white quartz and quartzite, scattered white tuffaceous? clay.
365-370	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 90% and clay as 360-365 above.
370-375	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 95%, clay, light grey, scattered loose quartz grains.
375-380	<u>Sand</u> , clear, light brown, medium to very coarse grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted, quartz, very dirty, common light brown and orange limonitic silty and clayey interstitial material, common very coarse grained and nodules of reddish-brown siderite, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments about 5% of the quartz has slight orange and yellow limonitic staining, loosely compacted.
380-385	<u>Sand</u> , as 375-380 above, except common very coarse grained and pebbles and fragments of quartz and quartzite, scattered to rare sideritic clay fragments, common carbonaceous wood fragments.
385-390	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , medium grey, scattered orange-brown, very coarse grained and small pebbles and fragments of quartz and quartzite set in silty matrix, rare white tuffaceous? clay, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments.
390-395	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 385-390 above.
395-400	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 385-390 above, but less sandy, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay fragments.
400-405	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , light grey and fawn, common fine to very coarse grained quartz, common carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered fragments of sideritic clay, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
405-410	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 400-405 above, scattered orange and brown patches.
410-415	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 405-410 above, occasional angular fragments of white and cream vein quartz.
415-420	<u>Silt</u> , light grey and fawn, minor orange brown and reddish-brown, common carbonaceous wood fragments, occasional very coarse grained quartz, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
420-425	<u>Silt</u> , as 415-420 above, becoming sandy in places.
