

DEPTH	STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION
285-290	<u>Clayey Sand</u> , as 180-185 above, scattered orange clay inclusions and fine to coarse grained.
290-295	<u>Clayey Sand</u> , as 180-185 above, only fine to coarse grained.
295-300	<u>Sandy Clay</u> , as 190-195 above.
300-305	<u>Clayey Sand</u> , as 290-295 above
305-310	<u>Clayey Sand</u> , as 290-295 above, scattered angular fragments, dark orange and red-brown hard silicified silt.
310-315	<u>Sandy Clay</u> , as 190-195 above, angular fragments of hard silicified sand containing angular, coarse grained quartz, set in yellow limonitic matrix.
315-320	<u>Silty Sand</u> , clear, light brown, orange, pink, fine to very coarse grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted, quartz, very dirty, common light brown silty interstitial material, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, fine coal pieces, rare limonitic patches and rare sideritic clay fragments, moderately compacted.
320-325	<u>Sandy Clay</u> , 310-315 above, common carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered inclusions of red and purple clay, angular fragments of orange limonitic hard silicified sand.
325-330	<u>Sandy Clay</u> , as 320-325 above, scattered interbeds, fawn, orange, grey and pink clay.
330-335	<u>Sandy Clay</u> , as 325-330 above.
335-340	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , light to medium grey, common, fine to coarse grained quartz, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, occasional angular fragments of ferruginous, orange silicified, hard, silt, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
340-345	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 335-340 above, but no angular ferruginous fragments.
345-350	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , medium grey, scattered fine to coarse grained quartz, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered to rare orange and yellow clay inclusions, coarsely textured moderately compacted.
350-355	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 345-350 above, common yellow, brown and red clay lenses, scattered angular reddish-brown ferruginous silicified silt.
355-360	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 350-355 above.
360-365	<u>Clay</u> , medium brown and fawn, light grey, scattered yellow stringers and rare orange and red inclusions, occasional sandy silt stringers, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, finely to medium textured, moderately compacted.
365-370	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 345-350 above.
370-375	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 85%; 15% sandy silt as 345-350 above.
