DEPTH	STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION
485-490	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , as 480-485 above, common orange patches, occasional sandy carbonaceous mud inclusions (like gilsonite).
490-495	<u>Silty Clay</u> , mottled, medium and dark grey and brown, orange, red, yellow and white, very coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
495-500	<u>Silty Clay</u> , light and medium brown, scattered white stringers and rare yellow and orange streaks, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
500-505	<u>Silty Clay</u> , as 495-500 above, scattered yellow limonitic coated ferruginous nodules, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay inclusions, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
505-510	<u>Sandy Silt</u> , light brown, scattered yellow and orange patches, common fine to coarse grained quartz, rare to scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay inclusions, rare limonitic nodules, a few of quartz grains have slight orange staining, very coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
