

DEPTH	STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION
495-500	<u>Clay</u> , medium grey, scattered orange, yellow, white, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay fragments, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered coarse grained, medium textured, moderately compacted.
500-505	<u>Sandy Clay</u> , dark brown, scattered orange lenses, common fine to medium grained quartz, common carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered reddish-brown sideritic clay fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
505-510	<u>Sandy Clay</u> , as 500-505 above.
510-515	<u>Sandy Clay</u> , as 500-505 above, but medium greyish brown and scattered limonitic coated nodules.
515-520	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 80%, scattered stringers of medium grey and brown clay, scattered orange-brown sideritic clay fragments.
520-525	<u>Clay</u> , medium grey and brown, scattered orange patches, common carbonaceous wood fragments, rare coarse grained quartz, rare orange glassy mineral? scattered orange-brown sideritic clay fragments, rare limonitic nodules, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
525-530	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 70%, scattered fragments of sideritic clay, limonitic coated shale fragments and nodules, scattered stringers of medium grey clay.
530-535	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 80% as 525-530 above.
535-540	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 98%, scattered orange-brown sideritic clay fragments.
540-545	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 65%, as 525-530 above.
545-550	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 100%,
550-555	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 90%, scattered medium to dark grey and minor yellow and orange clay.
555-560	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , as 550-555 above.
560-565	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , as 550-555 above.
565-570	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 75%, as 550-555 above.
570-575	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , 70%, as 550-555 above.
575-580	<u>Silty Clay</u> , medium brown and orange-brown, orange and medium grey, common carbonaceous wood fragments (50%), coarsely textured, moderately to loosely compacted.
580-585	<u>Silty Clay</u> , as 575-580 above.
585-590	<u>Silty Clay</u> , as 580-585 above.
590-595	<u>Silty Clay</u> , as 580-585 above.
595-600	<u>Silty Clay</u> , light to medium brown, scattered orange patches, common carbonaceous wood fragments (30%), scattered orange-grown sideritic clay fragments, scattered limonite nodules coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
