

DEPTH	STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION
320-325	<u>Silty sand</u> , clear, light brown, rare reddish brown, very finely grained, sub-angular, medium to well sorted, quartz very dirty, common light brown and white silty and clayey interstitial material, rare purplish red nodules, moderately to loosely compacted.
325-330	<u>Sandy clay</u> , medium brown, scattered orange, trace white stringers, common clear, light brown, pink and reddish-brown quartz grains, occasional reddish-brown ferruginous shale plates.
330-335	<u>Silty sand</u> , as 320-325 above.
335-340	<u>Clay</u> , light and medium grey stringers, scattered carbonaceous fragments, scattered light tan and reddish brown grains and aggregates of siderite, scattered purplish and reddish-brown, limonitic clay inclusions, medium textured, moderately compacted.
340-345	<u>Clay</u> , white to light grey, scattered light tan and reddish-brown aggregates of siderite, scattered angular inclusions of reddish and orange dark tan limonitic shale, occasional ferruginous shale plates.
345-350	<u>Clay</u> , as 340-345 above.
350-360	Missing.
360-365	<u>Clay</u> , light grey and dark greyish brown stringers, rare purplish-brown lenses, and rare yellow small inclusions, rare carbonaceous specks, occasional reddish-brown siderite aggregates, medium textured, well compacted.
365-370	<u>Clay</u> , light grey, clear quartz grains, medium textured, well compacted.
370-375	<u>Clay</u> , as 365-370 above.
375-380	<u>Clay</u> , light and medium grey stringers, scattered light brown and clear quartz grains, rare carbonaceous specks, medium textured, moderately compacted.
380-385	<u>Silty sand</u> , clear, light brown, reddish-brown, very fine to finely grained, sub-angular, medium-poorly sorted, quartz, very dirty common light brown and minor white silty interstitial material, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, rare mica, loosely to moderately compacted.
385-390	<u>Clay</u> , light to medium grey, rare orange lenses and inclusions, scattered reddish-brown siderite grains and aggregates, scattered small carbonaceous wood fragments, rare mica, medium-coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
390-395	Clay, as 385-390 above.
395-400	Missing.
