190-195	<u>Clay</u> , dark brown, orange, yellow, minor white, light grey and red stringers, scattered carbonaceous (black) clay inclusions. Waxy in appearance.
195-200	<u>Clay</u> , as 190-195 above.
200-205	<u>Clay</u> , as 190-195 above.
205-210	<u>Clay</u> , as 190-195 above.
210-215	<u>Clay</u> , as 190-195 above.
215-220	<u>Clay</u> , as 190-195 above.
220-225	<u>Clay</u> , as 190-195 above.
225-230	<u>Clay</u> , as 190-195 above, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments.
230-235	<u>Clay</u> , medium brown and light tan, minor yellow and orange, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, medium textured, moderately compacted.
235-240	<u>Clay</u> , dark, medium brown, black carbonaceous clay, white, minor yellow and orange, medium textured, moderately compacted.
240-245	Missing
245-250	<u>Clay</u> , as 235-240 above
250-255	Missing
255-260	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> and black carbonaceous clay, rare yellow and orange clay inclusions.
260-265	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , as 255-260 above.
265-270	<u>Carbonaceous Wood Fragments</u> , and scattered medium brown, white, light grey, yellow and orange clay.
270-275	<u>Clay</u> , medium light brown or yellow and white stringers, common carbonaceous wood fragments, medium to coarsely textured, loosely compacted.
275-280	<u>Clay</u> , dark, medium, light brown, scattered orange, yellow and white stringers and lenses, rare carbonaceous wood fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
280-285	<u>Clay</u> , as 275-280, rare medium grained clear quartz.
285-290	<u>Clay</u> , as 275-280 above.
290-295	<u>Clay</u> , as 275-280 above, except scattered carbonaceous wood fragments.
295-300	<u>Clay</u> , as 290-295 above.
300-305	<u>Clay</u> , as 290-295 above.
305-310	<u>Clay</u> , as 290-295 above.
310-315	<u>Clay</u> , as 290-295 above, rare to scattered medium tan limonitic clay pebbles.
