585-590	<u>Clay</u> , medium greyish brown, rare orange inclusions, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, rare reddish-brown siderite clay angular inclusions.
590-595	<u>Clay</u> , as 585-590 above.
595-600	Missing.
600-605	<u>Clay</u> , as 585-590 above.
605-610	<u>Clay</u> , medium grey, orange, rare black stringers, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, finely to medium textured, moderately compacted.
610-615	<u>Clay</u> , medium grey, rare orange lenses and inclusions, one piece of grey clay shows a bluish-purple and bluish-green stain (may be vivianite?), scattered brown and reddish-brown sideritic clay, angular inclusions, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, finely to medium textured, moderately compacted.
615-620	<u>Clay</u> , medium grey, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, rare sideritic angular inclusions, finely to medium textured, moderately compacted.
620-625	<u>Clay</u> , medium to light brown, scattered orange lenses, scattered reddish-brown, sideritic clay angular inclusions (may be bands broken up by the drill), scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, medium-textured, moderately compacted.

635-640	<u>Clay</u> , medium and dark grey, scattered orange lenses, occasional reddish-brown, angular sideritic clay inclusions, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, rare mica, medium textured, moderately compacted.

665-670	<u>Clay</u> , as 635-640 above

700-705	<u>Clay</u> , as 635-640 above, minor white streaks
705-710	<u>Clay</u> , dark grey, minor orange streaks and inclusions, common carbonaceous wood fragments, medium-textured, moderately compacted.
