725-730	<u>Clay</u> , light and medium grey, stringers, scattered to common carbonaceous wood fragments, rare yellow glassy mineral, rare yellow fibrous mineral? rare mica, rare to scattered reddish-brown angular sideritic clay inclusions.
730-735	<u>Clay</u> , as 725-730 above
735-740	<u>Clay</u> , as 725-730 above
740-745	<u>Clay</u> , medium grey, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
745-750	<u>Clay</u> , as 740-745 above.
750-755	<u>Clay</u> , medium grey, rare yellow specks and inclusions, common carbonaceous wood fragments and matter, medium textured, moderately compacted.
755-760	<u>Clay</u> , as 750-755 above, scattered white silt stringers.
760-765	<u>Clay</u> , as 750-755 above.
765-770	<u>Clay</u> , as 750-755 above.
770-775	<u>Clay</u> , as 750-755 above.
775-780	<u>Clay</u> , as 750-755 above.

790-795	<u>Clay</u> , medium greyish brown, rare orange specks, common carbonaceous wood fragments, medium textured, moderately compacted.

810-815	<u>Clay</u> , as 790-795 above, rare very finely grained sand streaks.
