STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 320-325 Clay, medium brown, scattered yellow stringers and orange inclusions, occasional white clay inclusions, scattered pebbles of quartz up to 1/8" diameter, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 325-330 Clay, medium grey and greyish-brown, rare white and yellow inclusions, scattered finely divided mica, rare fragments of quartzite, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 330-335 Clay, as 325-330 above, rare carbonaceous wood fragments and yellow tinges.
- 335-340 Clay, medium brown, occasional carbonaceous wood fragments medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 340-345 Clay, as 300-305 above.
- 345-350 Clay, as 325-330 above.
- 350-355 Clay, medium brown, rare white and cream clay inclusions.
- 355-360 Clay, medium brown, scattered white, cream and yellow lenses and inclusions, rare carbonaceous wood fragments, rare finely divided mica, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 360-365 Clay, as 355-360 above.
- 365-370 Clay, medium grey, rare to scattered white clay inclusions, rare carbonaceous blebs, finely to medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 370-375 Clay, as 365-370 above, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments.
- 375-380 Clay, medium grey and greyish-brown, scattered orange clay fragments, rare fine grained quartz, rare carbonaceous blebs, medium textured, moderately compacted.
