355-360	<u>Clay</u> , as 345-350 above.
360-365	<u>Clay</u> , light fawn, medium grey and brown, scattered scattered white and orange inclusions, scattered finely grained quartz, scattered medium grey quartzite fragments, scattered reddish brown sideritic clay nodules, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
360-365	<u>Clay</u> , as 355-360 above.
365-370	<u>Clay</u> , as 355-360 above.
370-375	<u>Clay</u> , as 355-360 above.
375-380	<u>Clay</u> , as 355-360 above, predominantly medium grey.
380-385	<u>Clay</u> , as 355-360 above.
385-390	<u>Clay</u> , as 375-380 above.
390-395	<u>Clay</u> , as 355-360 above.
395-400	<u>Clay</u> , as 355-360 above.
400-405	<u>Clay</u> , as 375-380 above.
405-410	<u>Clay</u> , as 355-360 above.
410-415	<u>Clay</u> , Medium grey, scattered fawn and minor orange inclusions, rare sub-rounded, clear medium grained quartz, rare reddish-brown sideritic clay inclusions, finely to medium textured, moderately compacted.
415-420	<u>Clay</u> , medium brown scattered orange and white inclusions, scattered red-brown sideritic clay inclusions, rare medium to coarse grained sub-rounded quartz, medium textured, moderately compacted.
420-425	<u>Clay</u> , as 415-420 above, rare carbonaceous-wood fragments, but no sideritic clay nodules.
425-430	<u>Clay</u> , as 420-425 above, scattered carbonaceous mud fragments, rare dark grey quartzite fragments.
430-435	<u>Clay</u> , medium brown, fawn, scattered orange steaks, scattered carbonaceous streaks and coal lenses, scattered siderite bands, medium textured, moderately compacted.
435-440	<u>Clay</u> , light fawn, medium greyish-brown, minor yellow stringers and streaks, rare coal streaks, rare reddish-brown sideritic clay nodules, medium textured, moderately compacted.
440-445	<u>Clay</u> , medium grey, scattered orange stringers and minor white inclusions, scattered reddish brown sideritic inclusions, scattered coal fragments, and carbonaceous wood fragments, medium textured, moderately compacted.
445-450	<u>Clay</u> , as 440-445 above, rare greenish grey quartzite fragments.
450-455	<u>Clay</u> , medium greyish-brown, scattered, light to medium brown clay inclusions rare orange inclusions, scattered black carbonaceous mud, rare medium-coarsely grained, sun-angular, clean quartz, medium textured, moderately compacted.
